Your views matter and are extremely valuable to the Committee of the Regions, since it is only by collecting more information that the Committee can represent the interests of local and regional authorities in the legislative process of the European Union most efficiently.

You can navigate all parts of the web site as **a regular user** . Click on: http://portal.cor.europa.eu/subsidiarity




- What is subsidiarity: discover the meaning and the history of the subsidiarity Principle

- News: Archive of the News of the SMN


How to register as a partner?

You can navigate as a **registered user** and have the possibility to exchange information with other local and regional authorities, and institutions in the European Union regarding various documents and legislative and political proposals from the European Union.

1. Click on JOIN US



2. Fill the form




 Your request will then be studied by the SMN secretariat and the application of your authority, association or institution will be forwarded to the CoR President and first Vice- President for approval

3. Receiving a password


Once the application is approved, you will receive an e-mail alert with a password



4. Click on LOGIN




5. Fill in your username and password



How to upload documents?

Once logged in, you can upload your document either:

- As a reply to a "targeted" or "impact assessment" consultation. It is very simple: an email alert is sent to all partners and you only have to follow a link to upload your contribution
- In the context of an "Open Consultation", i.e. spontaneous partner's contributions, you first need to find the European Commission document you want to comment. Fill in the search field if you know the exact number (ex COM (2010) 750) or click on "Search"



Once you have found the commission document of interest using the search tools, you Can declare your "work in progress" or upload your "observations".
